## Eligibility

## Session Tracks

Workshop idea submissions should falls into one or more of the following issue-areas, which will serve as the Conference’s learning tracks:

- I. **Generational Change:** Workshops should address issues facing the next-generation of leadership; inter-generational transition and ‘expansion’ in foundations and nonprofits; generational transfer of wealth; and related topics.
- II. **Philanthropic Effectiveness:** Sessions would offer concrete philanthropic skills (of the ‘how-to’ variety or the ‘softer’ skills such as diplomacy, managing-up, etc.); address career advancement and workplace challenges for diverse emerging foundation professionals; or offer solution-oriented ideas to increase the efficiency and efficacy of foundations.
- III. **Social Justice Philanthropy:** Workshops should share actionable ideas, practices, processes, outcomes and challenges of grantmaking and other foundation activities that advance healthy, fair, and just communities in the US and beyond.
